

Certified Management Consultant (CMC)

How to become a CMC?

- Candidates must have at least **five years of experience in the full-time** practice of management consulting.
- Pledge in writing to adhere to the Institute's **Code of Ethics**.
- **Two sponsors** who are full members or fellows (CMC, FCMC, and FIMC).
- Complete **"Management Consulting: A Workshop for Professionals"** for the fee of JD240 for Members & JD360 for none members
- **Fill the CMC application form** for a non-refundable fee of JD100.
- Provide **six clients and professional references** to assure that all consulting relationships are satisfactory.
- Provide **five written summaries** of consulting engagements managed by yourself.
- **Pass a written examination** for the fee of JD50 and an **oral interview** for the fee of JD50 by a panel of three CMC's to verify the applicant's technical and professional competence.
- The certification fees are JD100 upon completion of all of the above.
- **TOTAL Certification fees = JD300 exclusive of CMC Workshop attendance & the total of JD540 inclusive of CMC Workshop attendance.**
